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## Gender Equality Misunderstood: Feminism Beyond the Stereotypes of Hate and Dominance

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*Feminism refers to the equality of genders and ensuring that no gender should be faced with unfairness. Therefore, it talks about gender justice and equality in treatment. A feminist is a person who advocates for such issues. However, in recent times, a lot of misconceptions, misunderstandings, and hatred have been formed against feminists. Recently, a new term has emerged, i.e. 'Pseudo-feminism,' which has led to unnecessary hatred towards females and feminists. Although there is no denying that some women misuse the laws in their favour, it does not give a free hand to the patriarchal mindset to attack the feminist community. For years, patriarchal ideologies have tried to oppress women. The spread of feminism helped women to demand equal rights. Unfortunately, even after the growth of modernisation and globalisation, women still have to demand their rights and respect in society. A widely held belief in society by fearful men is that feminism aims to spread hatred towards men. Another stereotype is that feminism evokes women's dominance over men. This paper seeks to analyse the misunderstandings and misconceptions about feminism. The author also attempts to analyse the society's perception and views on 'feminism'.*

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## INTRODUCTION

Women form about half of the population of the country. However, their situation has been gloomy. It is unfortunate that for centuries, they have been denied growth opportunities and have been oppressed. In the name of culture and tradition, the Indian society has always preferred a male child over a female. This has led to male domination in the country. Due to this, females have been discriminated against and exploited. The violence against women and girls has adverse effects on the sex ratio in our country. Women have been deprived of educational opportunities and economic independence. This has also led to undermining their role in the decision-making process. Even though reports show that women work more than men and are burdened with long working hours, their conditions continue to be miserable as they remain underpaid. Women in this country have faced various forms of humiliation and torture. Even after many initiatives for promoting independence for women, our country is far behind and has miles to go to achieve the goal. Feminism has helped women to gain rights and overcome all the above hurdles faced by them. However, the attitudes towards feminism had now grown quite negative. This scenario is rather sad, as feminism is not a negative term, but it is being put out in a bad light by portraying it wrongly.

Despite having laws that promote and protect the rights of women, the society's mentality on feminism poses a hurdle. The Constitution of India guarantees several rights to women enshrined under Articles 14, 15, 16 and 19<sup>1</sup>. A bundle of rights for women have been included in Article 21<sup>2</sup> by judicial interpretations. These include the right to dignity, the right to reproductive health, the right to abortion, etc. Gender specific legislations like the Domestic Violence Act 2005<sup>3</sup> and the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act 2013<sup>4</sup> also exist to protect women. Though the parliament and judiciary are both progressive in protecting women, the societal attitude might seem regressive towards them.

## **STATEMENT OF RESEARCH PROBLEM**

Feminism refers to the equality of genders and ensuring that no gender should be faced with unfairness. Therefore, it talks about gender justice and equality in treatment. A feminist is a person who advocates for such issues. However, in recent times, a lot of misconceptions, misunderstandings, and hatred have been formed against feminists. Recently, a new term has emerged, i.e. 'Pseudo-feminism,' which has led to unnecessary hatred towards females and feminists. Although there is no denying that some women misuse the laws in their favour, it does not give a free hand to the patriarchal mindset to attack the feminist community. For years, patriarchal ideologies have tried to oppress women. The spread of feminism helped women to demand equal rights. Unfortunately, even after the growth of modernisation and globalisation, women still have to demand their rights and respect in society. A widely held belief in society by fearful men is that feminism aims to spread hatred towards men. Another stereotype is that feminism evokes women's dominance over men.

## **OBJECTIVES OF THE STUDY**

1. To examine the meaning of feminism and pseudo- feminism.
2. To analyse the societal misconceptions and stereotypes surrounding feminism as a concept of hate or dominance.
3. To study the reasons for the rise in myths towards feminism.
4. To analyse society's perception and views on feminism.
5. To explore how these misconceptions hinder progress toward achieving true gender equality.

## **HYPOTHESIS**

1. The Indian society has a negative perception of feminism.
2. The Indian society is not aware of the true meaning of feminism.

## **RESEARCH QUESTIONS**

1. What is the meaning and difference between feminism and pseudo-feminism?
2. What are the various societal misconceptions and stereotypes surrounding feminism?
3. What are the reasons for the rise in myths towards feminism?
4. How does the Indian society perceive and view the concept of feminism?

## **RESEARCH METHODOLOGY**

For the Purpose of examining meaning, myths and cases of feminism and fake feminism, the researcher has referred to various articles and journals of reputed nature. To study the perceptions and views on Indian society towards feminism, the research was empirical. The researcher adopted the questionnaire method to gather primary data. A questionnaire was distributed amongst seventy Indian research participants of all genders and ages residing in the Delhi NCR Region.

## **THE MEANING OF FEMINISM AND FAKE FEMINISM**

The perception of feminism as a tool for advancing women's interests over men's has created significant polarisation in societal discourse. Misconception about feminism is in itself an injustice. Unfortunately, it cannot be denied that some women who portray themselves as feminists have created a misunderstood form of women's empowerment. One of the biggest misconceptions is that many people think that when feminists talk about 'equality', they relate it to 'similarity'. Hence, it is often perceived that 'women and men are the same'. However, men and women are different biologically, and the same cannot be denied. Feminism has often been mischaracterised as a movement that fosters animosity toward men or seeks gender dominance rather than equality. Such misconceptions create barriers to understanding its true goals. Today's feminism has become a blend of traditional and modern feminism. This has led to the creation of irrelevant issues. E.g.: How a girl is supposed to sit is also a part of etiquette and grooming. However, it is now being converted into a feminist issue.

Social media has been an excellent platform for feminists and has given rise to powerful movements like the #MeToo movement, which exposed sexual harassers on Twitter. This movement gave courage to many victims of sexual harassment to come forward and tell their stories. This also led to women commissioning Suo Moto actions against many perpetrators. However, social media has also led to many downfalls of feminism. Unnecessary protests have led to suppressing the real issues faced by women- domestic violence, sexual harassment, rape, acid attacks, eve-teasing, etc. Teenagers have gained the wrong perception of the word feminism. They have formed their own opinions (influenced by social media as being 'trendy') that feminism means hating, bashing and insulting men.

Feminism demands equality, which actually promotes harmony among all genders. Being one of the most progressive concepts, it is also one of the most hated concepts as well. Feminism refers to the equality of genders and ensuring that no gender should be faced with unfairness. Therefore, it talks about gender justice and equality in treatment.

A feminist is a person who advocates for such issues. However, in recent times, a lot of misconceptions, misunderstandings, and hatred have been formed against feminists. Recently, a new term has emerged, i.e. 'Pseudo-feminism,' which has led to unnecessary hatred towards females and feminists. Although there is no denying that some women misuse the laws in their favour, it does not give a free hand to the patriarchal mindset to attack the feminist community. For years, patriarchal ideologies have tried to oppress women. The spread of feminism helped women to demand equal rights. Unfortunately, even after the growth of modernisation and globalisation, women still have to demand their rights and respect in society. A widely held belief in society by feared men is that feminism aims to spread hatred towards men. Another stereotype is that feminism evokes women's dominance over men.

## **STEREOTYPES AND MYTHS REGARDING FEMINISM**

Certain myths and stereotypes regarding feminism exist when people fail to understand the true meaning of feminism. The most common one being that feminism means hating men or considering that females are superior. Some of these are as follows:

- Feminism promotes the superiority of women,
- Feminism seeks to establish a matriarchy by abolishing patriarchy,
- Feminism supports women only.
- Feminists are often 'angry' or aggressive,
- Feminists hate men,
- Feminists believe that men and women are both 'similar',
- Feminists believe that women are better than men,
- Feminism means bashing men,
- Only women can be feminists,
- Feminists believe that since women have suffered years of discrimination, they can be excused for their behaviour, no matter what.

- Feminists believe that all women are disadvantaged in society and all men are privileged by birth.

## CASES OF FAKE FEMINISM THAT HAVE TRIGGERED HATRED TOWARDS FEMINISTS

**The Bois Locker Room Case:** During the 2020 pandemic lockdown, the nation was shocked to see an offensive screenshot of an Instagram group where underage and young boys were objectifying girls and talking of gang raping them. Many screenshots were leaked, but during the police investigation, it was revealed that certain screenshots were actually of a girl posing as a boy to check the character of the other boy.<sup>5</sup> This took an ugly turn, where the public who had earlier been in support of the girls were turned against them.

**Amity University Car Parking Case:** A female student of the university had parked her car in the middle of the road, which led to an argument with two other boys. Reportedly, the girl called her male friends, who attacked the two boys. Later on, she filed a fake case of molestation against the two boys.

**Neha Dhupia's Controversial Comment on National Television:** Actress Neha Dhupia gave a rather controversial statement on a show where she said that if a man physically assaults a woman, it isn't acceptable, but a woman being physically violent towards a man is justified.<sup>6</sup> Eventually, social media was flooded by people who called her a fake/pseudo-feminist.

**Lucknow Driver Assault Case:** It was alleged by the girl that the cab driver hit her with his vehicle. She physically assaulted the driver and slapped him 22 times.<sup>7</sup> There is CCTV footage of the same, and no one is seen coming to the driver's defence.

**Bengaluru Woman's assault on Zomato Delivery Boy:** Media coverage of incidents such as the Bengaluru Woman's Assault on Zomato Delivery Boy has reinforced the stereotype of feminism as a misused tool for manipulation. The woman, who was a content creator, posted a video online depicting that a Zomato Delivery Boy had attacked her, which led to her nose bleeding and injury. Upon investigation, it was found that the allegations made by the woman were false, and it was she who had been physically violent towards the boy.<sup>8</sup>

**Jasleen Kaur Harassment Case:** This was one of the most unfortunate cases that happened at the peak of feminism in the country, while the country was still grieving from the loss of the Nirbhaya case. In 2015, a woman in Delhi named Jasleen Kaur alleged that a boy had harassed her and filed molestation charges against him. For years, he suffered, lost his job, and his reputation was spoiled. After the police investigation, it was found out that Jasleen had put false allegations against him, and rather she was the one who was at fault.<sup>9</sup>

## DATA ANALYSIS AND OBSERVATION

The following observations were made (by the researcher) based on the survey.<sup>10</sup> Conducted & data gathered from 70 research participants:<sup>11</sup> This survey received 51.4% responses from female participants & 48.6% from males. The participants were inclusive of all genders & age. The maximum participants (37.1%) were from the age bracket of 27-37, while the second highest participants (30%) were from the age bracket of 18-26.

**Awareness of Feminism:** Majority of the participants (87.1%) agreed that feminism stands for advocating for equal rights of both men and women, while 11.4 % believed that it meant promoting the superiority of women, and feminists support women only. 4.3% participants were of the view that feminism seeks to establish matriarchy by abolishing patriarchy. One participant wrote, 'Nowadays feminism has more than one meaning, gets confused with mixing of sarcasm, but will try to fill this form thinking that feminism demands equal rights.'

One participant was completely ignorant of the idea and wrote that 'feminism means having sexual intercourse with a female'.

The findings suggest that conceptually, most of the participants understood the meaning of feminism, but misconceptions about the meaning still existed for some who associated its meaning with matriarchal or female dominance.

**Stereotypes associated with Feminism:** Maximum participants (65.7%) agreed that feminists believe that men and women are 'equal'. However, 15.7% thought that feminists believe that women and men are 'similar'. 20% (the second-highest majority) thought that feminists believe that women are better than men. 11.4 % thought that feminists hate men, 10% thought feminists are often angry or aggressive, and 8.6% thought that it means bashing men. One participant agreed with all the opinions listed and said that 'different people have different opinions of feminists, so all opinions are true'. One participant went out of his way and wrote offensive and abusive words for feminists.

Most of the participants (32.9%) were of the view that feminists believe that women can always be excused because of the discrimination they have suffered, therefore they never have to take responsibility for their behaviour and that feminism purports that feminists believe all women are disadvantaged in our society & all men are privileged by their gender. 17.1% thought that now there is no need for feminism as women have votes, rights and jobs, so the goal is already met. One participant opined that women are definitely growing, they are earning well, the law is supporting, an educated society is supporting women, but it is a matter of hundreds of years, & it can't be going.

**Inclusivity of Feminism:** Majority of the participants (80%) agreed that anyone, irrespective of their gender or sexuality, could be a feminist, while 18.6% believed only women can be feminists. One participant stated that to be a feminist you need to be a person who thinks that women are also human beings and not some object to be used, while another participant wrote that 'only stupid people can be feminist.'

**Workplace Equality:** Maximum participants (74.3%) believed that feminism can be a goal/career-oriented women as well as a housewife, while 7.1% thought that only goal/career- oriented females can be feminist. One participant said, 'A feminist is a person who thinks that society is run by both. Only a man can't run this society, and only women

can't run this society.' A feminist is someone who talks about the rights and equality of women. However, one participant quoted, 'All feminists are horrible.'

### **PERCEPTIONS ON GENDER ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

87.1% of the participants agreed that men and women deserve equal pay for equal work. One participant was of the view that 'it depends on the output they generate. For me, it is fair to give more money to female models than male models, more money to male sportspersons than female.'

Only 44.3% agreed that it is fair for women to receive months of paid maternity leave while men do not get the same paternity benefit, and 37.1% of the participants were against it. One participant said that both are equally responsible for caring and looking after the child, while another said that maybe the same benefit is not provided, but the concept of paternity leave is required. One participant said that 'women should get a longer maternity leave than a man getting paternity leave because of the obvious health issues, but this doesn't mean that a father is not entitled to experience those days with his child'. Another participant was of the same view and stated that 'Although it is fair, laws must be there to provide similar kinds of things for male parent- may be a smaller number of days'. One participant said that 'economically our country is not so sound that it can afford this, otherwise a child needs both mother and father.'

**Cultural Narratives and Victim Blaming:** Only 51.4% 'strongly disagreed' that if a woman is dressed provocatively, men cannot be held accountable for acting on their sexual desires. 15.7% remained neutral, while one participant said: 'It depends on the environment and culture of men, otherwise dress cannot provoke anyone. It depends on the mentality of a person.'

7.1% believed that feminists are less attractive than non-feminists, while 24.3% chose the 'maybe' option. One participant sarcastically wrote, 'I want to say yes for so many examples that I have in my head, but all of them are fake feminist, so I will say NO'.

### **UNDERSTANDING OF WOMEN'S EMPOWERMENT**

Only 45.7% agreed that it is not acceptable that women are sexualized in advertisements, while 32.9% were neither able to agree nor disagree. 12.9% thought that it is acceptable if it

increases sales. One participant responded that as long as it does not harm any individual, it is fine, while another said that it is acceptable until it violates any law. Another participant said that it happens with both men and women when giant companies play with the desires of the public. One participant was of the view that women are a huge customer base in our country, so no harm in this, while another said that sexualization of women is not feminism. A participant stated that 'it is definitely not acceptable, though from a business perspective it might increase sales, but that might not always be true because usually women make decisions about buying household stuff. Also, in the long term, it impacts society at large & makes society think and see women as less capable and less intelligent. Respectful and multi-dimensional portrayal of women and girls can help bring an end to inequality.'

The majority of the participants (67.1%) were in favour that women's empowerment will lead to the development of society. Only 48% agreed that what a woman wears should not affect the likelihood of sexual harassment. 30% were of the view that women are given equal rights in India. 14.3% said that women's empowerment will lead to the westernisation of India. 18.6% thought that the government policies and laws are enough to resolve women-related issues, which 2.9% said that it is natural for women to stay at home and look after children while the man goes to work.

## **UNDERSTANDING OF PSEUDO-FEMINISM**

The majority of the participants thought that pseudo-feminism means women who disguise their own affairs in the name of feminism and believe in bashing men. 31.4% said they were not familiar with the term, while 8.6% said it is just another name for feminism. One participant said that it is a term for fake feminism, while another said that pseudo-feminism relates to women's supremacy and men's hatred- basically, someone who claims to be feminist yet ignores the main point underlying feminism.

## **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS**

It can be concluded that even though some responses by the participants were positive, there remains a huge gap to bridge in order to achieve a state of true feminism. Hypothesis 1 has turned out to be partially true, which has made respondents have negative answers on feminism, whereas Hypothesis 2 turned out to be false, as the majority of the participants could form an accurate opinion of feminism.

The author suggests that educational institutions should integrate gender studies into their curriculum. Though the Bar Council of India mandates the course of Gender Justice in the law syllabus, awareness should be created from school days itself to remove misconceptions on feminism and equality. Also, the media has the utmost duty to ensure sensitivity in reporting cases, as sometimes feminism may be misrepresented by them to make their news more sensational.

It is up to us to be a solution-oriented society and make peace our priority. One must remember that only a criminal is held liable for his crime and not the entire gender to which they belong; similarly, one must not blame an entire gender when it comes to feminism. Feminism seeks harmony and equality rather than dominance or hatred.

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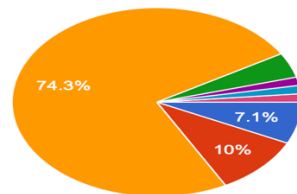

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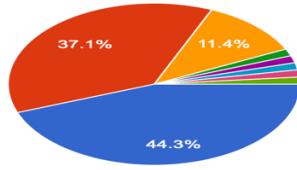

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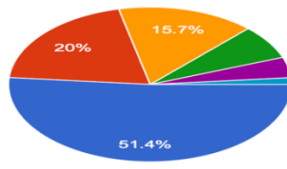

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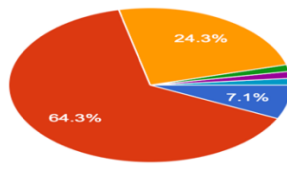

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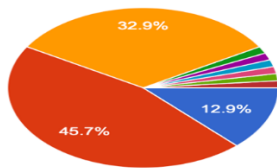

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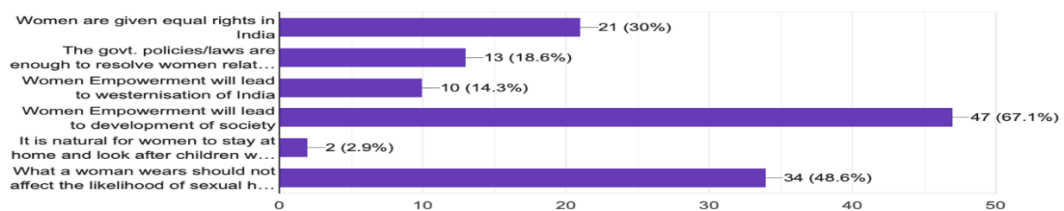
